His poetry associates him with Harlech, and, more especially, with Trawsfynydd. *Cywyddau* and an *englyn* by him are preserved in Cwrtmawr MSS. 238, 244, N.L.W. MSS. 643, 666, 3487, and B.M. Add. MSS. 14966, 14985; among them is an *englyn* to the town of Harlech, and a '*cywydd* of remonstrance against the world written by a man who had sold his land,' that is Hendre-fawr, Trawsfynydd.
