This includes *englynion* in praise of [Gruffudd Dwnn](#)'s mansion in Ystrad Merthyr ([Llanstephan MS 40](#)  (60)), a *cywydd* written to Sir Harry ap Sir Thomas Johns of Abermarlais ([Llanstephan MS 30](#)  (444)), and another to [Sir John Perrot](#) (see the article on the family) of Pembrokeshire ([Llanstephan MS 30](#)  (447)).
