MS. 14402 : ' Chwech o Benhillion a ddanfonwyd mewn llythyr o Flanders yn amser y Frenhines Anne, at fy Mam, ac mi welais gyffhelyb i'r peth ar ôl hynnu yn Flanders yn amser George yr Ail, ar Galon Drom.'
