He was educated at Ystrad Meurig, Accrington Academy, and the University of Glasgow, and ministered at Grosvenor Street, Manchester, 1851-8, and Greenfield, Llanelly, Carmarthenshire, 1858-70. He was editor of the *Llanelly Telegraph*, 1860-7; he also published *Memoirs of Christmas Evans*. He died 31 January 1870.
