A number of his *cywyddau* have been preserved, including an elegy on the death of Henry VI, a number of vaticinatory poems, and three love poems, two poems composed by <u>Llywelyn Goch y Dant</u> and Gruffydd ap Dafydd Fychan after reading the elegy of <u>Hywel ap Dafydd ap Ieuan ap Rhys</u> on <u>Ieuan ap Hywel Swrdwal</u>. Two *englynion*, presumably composed by a son of his, Owain, are found in Pen. MS. 77 (319).
