Born at T r-gwyn, Tredraur ('Troed-yr-aur'), Cardiganshire, where he died, 'being nearly 80 years of age.' Between 1672 and 1722 he wrote a considerable number of carols of the type known as *halsingod* and in 1718 published, jointly with <u>Samuel Williams</u> of Llandyfrïog, a selection of them, bearing the title *Pedwar o Ganuau*. Only one of his *cywyddau* survives - the 'Cywydd i'r lesu o gynnildeb wyneb yngwrthwyneb 'printed in *Meddylieu Neillduol ar Grefydd* (1717). He produced a number of *englynion* and at least one 'summer carol.' We hear of him being present at the Machynlleth eisteddfod, 1702, where he was lampooned by <u>Siôn Rhydderch</u>. <u>laco ab Dewi</u> wrote a poem in his honour, while <u>Siencyn Thomas</u> of Cwm-du and <u>Alban Thomas</u> of Blaen-porth wrote elegies upon him.
