

## GRUFFUDD NANNAU (fl. c. 1460) poet

A member apparently of the [Nannau](#) family. He was contemporary with [Dafydd ap Maredudd ap Tudur](#), fl. 1460. Some examples of his work exist in manuscript, and these include an *englyn* written to the poet [Gruffudd Phylip](#) (N.L.W. MS. 643 (39b)), a *cywydd* to the sons of [Ieuan Fychan](#) of Pengwern (died c. 1458) (Cardiff MS. 83 (28b)); Mostyn MS. 146 (500)), and another to Dafydd Llwyd ap Gruffudd Deuddwr (Peniarth MS. 64 (236)).
