MS. 5269 (211)); Wynnstay MS. 6 (170)), others addressed to [Gruffudd ap Nicolas](#) of Dynevor (N.L.W. MS. 6511 (194b)), Dafydd ap Ieuan ab Owain of Caereinion (Brogyntyn MS. 1 (128)), and [Dafydd Llwyd ap Dafydd ab Einion](#) of Newtown (N.L.W. Add.
