The entry of his christening has not been found, but he was certainly buried there, 10 June 1813, at the age of sixty-six. [Cynddelw](#) (Robert Ellis) had a high opinion of him as a poet. We have, in the handwriting of his son George Humphreys (N.L.W. MS. 6729), copies of his poems.
