Much of his work remains in manuscript, and this includes poems written to members of the Abertanad, Mold, [Ynys-ymaengwyn](#), and [Gwydir](#) families, another addressed to [Dafydd ab Owain](#), abbot of Strata Marcella, a satire on Flint, and satirical *englynion* forming part of the bardic controversy, or *ymryson*, between [Guto'r Glyn](#) and Ieuan.
