No details concerning his life are known, but three interesting poems by him remain, these being (1) ' Cywydd y Gown Coch ', (2) a begging ' Llyfr y Greal ' (see *Cywyddau'r Ychwanegiad*, 144) from the abbot of Glyn Nedd, and (3) a *cywydd* in which the poet seeks the whereabouts of [Llywelyn Goch y Dant](#) from a woman winnowing barley.
