Some of his work exists in manuscript, and this includes *cywyddau* composed between c. 1577 and 1596, to members of the Cefn Digoll, Gartheryr, Mallwyd, [Mathafarn](#), and Moelyrch families, and a *cywydd* to the trout. The following manuscripts contain examples of his poems: Cardiff MS. 84; Cwrtmawr MSS. 12, 21, 207; [Llanstephan MS 118](#), [Llanstephan MS 133](#), [Llanstephan MS 155](#); Pen. MS. 87. The dates given him in *Blackwell* and *Cymru (O.J.)* are more than a hundred years too early.
