

IEUAN CLYWEDOG (fl. 1577-1596), poet

A native, apparently, of the Clywedog Valley in Montgomeryshire. Some of his work exists in manuscript, and this includes *cywyddau* composed between c. 1577 and 1596, to members of the Cefn Digoll, Gartheryr, Mallwyd, Mathafarn, and Moelyrch families, and a *cywydd* to the trout. The following manuscripts contain examples of his poems: Cardiff MS. 84; *Cwrtmawr MS 12B*, *Cwrtmawr MS 21B*, *Cwrtmawr MS 207B*; *Llanstephan MS 118*, *Llanstephan MS 133*, *Llanstephan MS 155*; *Peniarth MS 87*. The dates given him in *Blackwell* and *Cymru (O.J.)* are more than a hundred years too early.
