He wrote poems to various contemporary North Wales gentry, including <u>Owain Holant</u> of Plas Berw, Anglesey, Hwmffrai ap Huw of Gwerclys, <u>Rhobert Wyn</u> of Foelas, <u>Edwart ap Dafydd</u> of Rhiwlas, Edwart ap Morus of Llansilin, Owain Bruwtwn (Brereton) of Bwras (Borras), Huw Morus ap leuan of Cefn Hir and Siôn Eutun of Coed Llai (Leeswood).
