Over eighty examples of poems by him are preserved in N.L.W. MS. 346, these being in the form of *cywyddau*, *englynion*, *carolau*, and *cerddi*, dated variously between 1768 and 1786 and all in Welsh except the ' Election Song written on the Carnarvon Election ' [1774].
