Three examples of his work remain, these being ' Ymddiddan rhwng y Cybydd a'r Trugarog,' ' Cyngor i'r Gôf o Rôs y Gwaliau,' and ' Cerdd i ŵr ifanc oedd yn glaf o gariad merch.' It is not clear whether there was any connection between him and two other poets from Llanuwchllyn - ROBERT JONES and ROLANT JONES (fl. 1762). A love ballad composed by the former is found in [NLW MS 645B](#) (34b), and examples of the latter's poetry is found in [NLW MS 672D](#) (257), [NLW MS 4698A](#) (141), and, possibly, in [Cwrtmawr MS 206B](#) (176), [NLW MS 4697A](#) (67) [NLW MS 12867D](#) (35), and Swansea MS. 3 (13). [It is possible that [Ioan Pedr](#) copied MSS. by these two - see *Journal of the Welsh Bibliographical Society*, iv, 4, p. 167.]
