He hailed from Aberdaron. His patrons included the families of [Bodeon](#), [Bodfel](#), [Cochwillan](#), [Glynllifon](#), and [Gwydir](#). He was also one of the poets who wrote an elegy on the death of [Tudur Aled](#). According to Pen. MS. 122 (122) he was buried at Nevin, though other sources state that he was buried at Llanegwad, Carmarthenshire. A selection of his work was published by [Myrddin Fardd](#) in *Cynfeirdd Lleyn*.
