Born at Denbigh, and brother of [Hugh Lloyd](#) (1546 - 1601). All that is known of him can be read in *D.N.B.* He was at Winchester and New College, Oxford, was Fellow of New College 1579-96, received the college living of Writtle (Essex) in 1598; died in 1603, and was buried at Writtle. He published *Josephus on the Maccabees* (with a Latin translation) in 1590, and Barlaam's tract on the Papacy in 1592.
